PROGRAM COSTS AND FINANCIAL AID

City Vision University costs \$7,000/year for full-time undergraduates, or \$8,000/year for graduate students. The cost per undergraduate course is \$233.33/credit hour, or \$700/course; graduate courses are \$266.67/credit hour, or \$800/course. Textbooks must be purchased separately.

Undergraduate students who qualify for federal aid may use Pell Grants to pay for City Vision University. Some scholarships may be available for specific classes or partner institutions.

ABOUT CITY VISION UNIVERSITY

History. City Vision University was established in 1998 as Rescue College, a program of the Association of Gospel Rescue Missions. In 2008, Rescue College became a part of the Christian nonprofit TechMission and was renamed City Vision College. It became City Vision University in 2015 with the addition of its graduate school.

Mission. Our mission is to provide radically affordable Christian education to underserved communities via distance learning.

Accreditation & Affiliations. We are accredited by the Distance Education Accrediting Commission and an affiliate member of the Association for Biblical Higher Education. DEAC is recognized by both the U.S. Department of Education and the Council for Higher Education Accreditation (CHEA).

1. CITY VISION INTERNSHIPS

A CHRISTIAN COUNTERPART TO AMERICORPS

City Vision Internships is a Christian counterpart to AmeriCorps that provides one year full time interns to ministries. In the past 10 years, we have placed over 500 full-time interns & 80,000 volunteers. We currently have 70+ ministry internship sites.

HOW IT WORKS

1. City Vision University provides a full tuition scholarship and/or helps recruit interns for your site.
2. After signing an agreement, your ministry interviews either the 500+ intern applicants we recruit annually or their own candidates.
3. Intern signs contract with ministry to serve 29-40 hours per week for one year at your ministry (like AmeriCorps or Peace Corps but without government restrictions on faith activities).

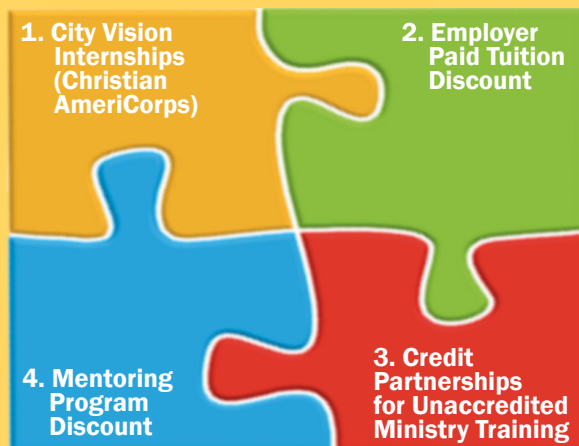
INTERN PLACEMENT FEES

Ministries pay a placement fee of \$4,500 to \$5,000 yearly for each intern placed, typically in five equal installments. Fees vary depending on the internship programs in which the ministry chooses to participate.

Four Partnership Options for \$4,500/year



Tuition discounted to only \$4,500/year in Options 1-3 . For student coaching, \$2,000 of the discount goes to pay the coach.

2. 35.7% PARTNER MINISTRY DISCOUNT FOR STAFF, INTERNS, VOLUNTEERS & PROGRAM PARTICIPANTS

Any ministry that uses one of the above partnership categories (Coaching, Credit, Internships) can receive a 35.7% partner discount for all staff, interns, volunteers and program participants. Other ministries may become a partner by committing to have at least two of their referrals start with City Vision over a 2 year period.

3. CREDIT PARTNERSHIPS FOR UNACCREDITED MINISTRY TRAINING

City Vision can provide Prior Learning Assessment evaluation of up to 30 credits for past ministry training or experience through our Prior Learning Assessment portfolio course.

EXISTING CREDIT PARTNERS

City Vision has partnerships with Wheeler Mission Biblical Counseling program, The Urban Ministry Institute (TUMI) and Mission Year. These programs provide intensive Bible and ministry courses for portfolio credit evaluation. City Vision has also partnered with the following organizations that receive UK Accreditation through GC4 to get UK credit to transfer to City Vision: YWAM University of the Nations, Third Millennium Ministries, Vision International University, Trinity Education and Savior Academy.

4. STUDENT COACHING PARTNER PROGRAM

Does your organization currently refer clients to community colleges? Our coaching program enables City Vision to serve as an alternative to community college while providing a revenue stream to your ministry. Approved coaches/organizations get \$2,000 per year per student they coach as students take City Vision courses online. We do this because we have found that online education can work much more effectively if there is a local coach to provide mentoring, accountability, and basic case management services.

HOW IT WORKS

1. Apply to become an approved student coach with City Vision.
2. If approved, you sign a Coaching Partner Memorandum of Understanding.
3. Full-time Pell grant students receive a \$1,500 scholarship, so their tuition is \$5,500. Full-time students receiving a full Pell grant of \$7,618 will get the remainder after tuition paid back to them as they complete courses. Note: students in mentoring programs do not qualify for other discounts beyond this.
4. You get paid \$2,000/year (or \$400/term) per full-time student that you coach.
